Kingston



KINGSTON SELF-DRIVE ITINERARY

DAY 1

Arrive in Kingston, ON

MORNING - Your CAA Travel Consultant can assist you in booking your **VIA Rail** pass, where CAA Members **SAVE up to 20%**.

DAY 2
